

Talking points


1. As the situation in Iraq grows worse, opposing politicians, pundits and editorial cartoonists are busy placing blame. Who are each of these cartoons blaming?

4. Is it the cartoonists' job to reflect their papers' editorial positions?


5. Find other examples of the blame game.
