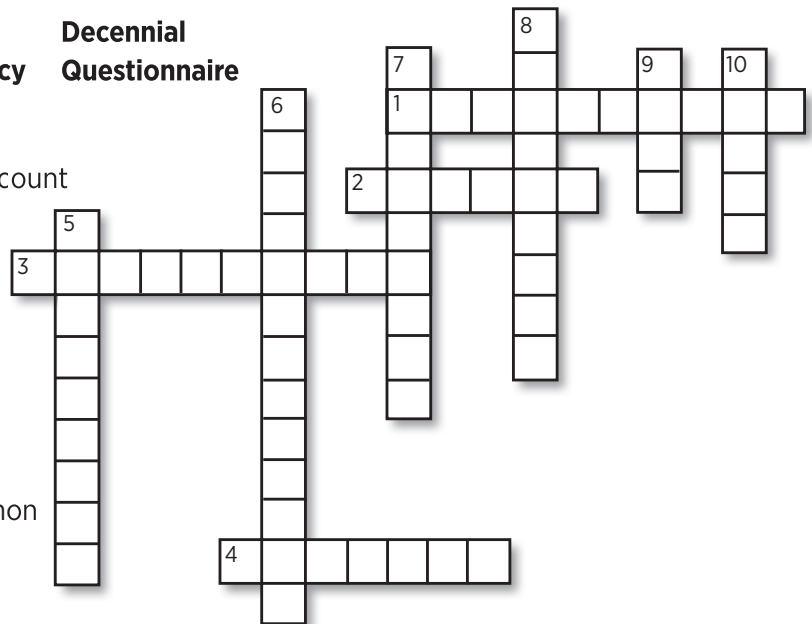

1. What is a census worker called?

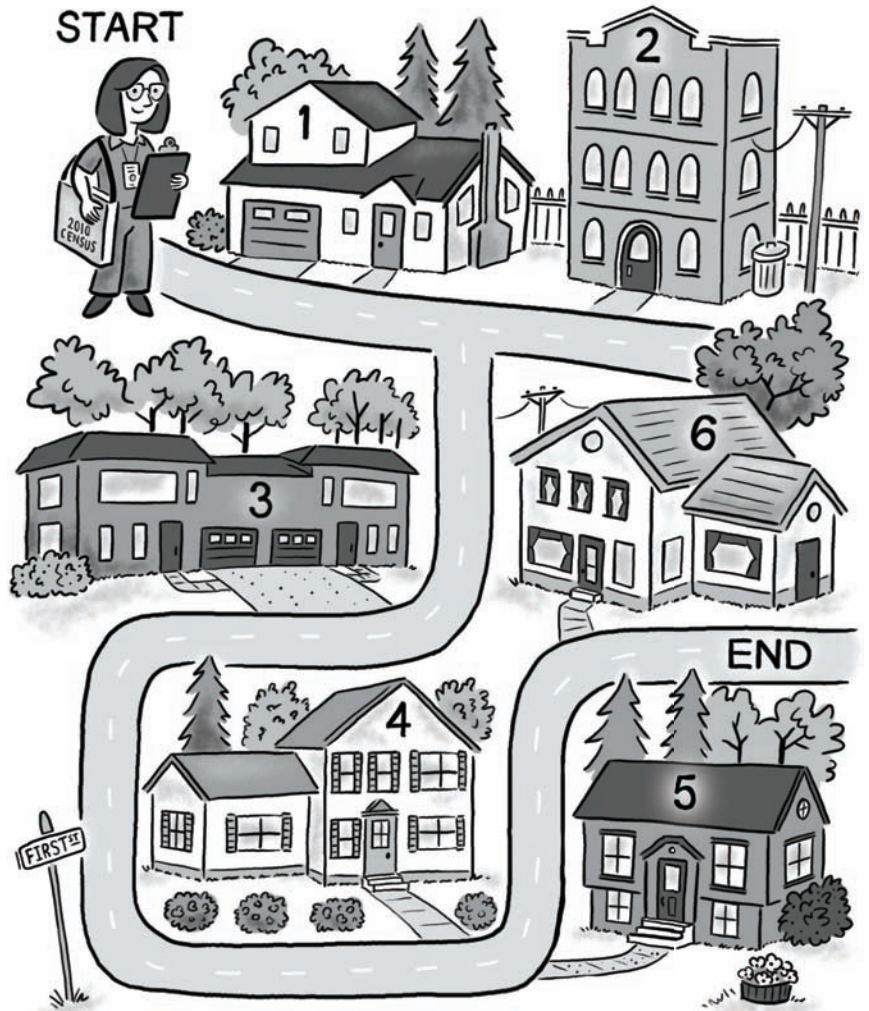
