OBJECTIVE:

Students will write an essay using writing skills.

PROMPT #1:

In your conclusion you might want to discuss what today's teens can learn about overcoming obstacles from reading these books. Choose examples from the books you've read and your own experience to support your response.

PROMPT#2:

All of the characters in the books you have read go on some sort of journey. What do their journeys have in common? How are they different? Do the characters make a journey into adulthood? or do they have to literally take a journey to survive? Write to compare and contrast the journeys of at least two characters you've read about. Use specific examples from the novels to support your response.
