

2011 Orlando Sentinel's Newspaper in Education Winter Contest - Official Rules – No Purchase Necessary

Contest runs from Tuesday, November 1, 2011 at 12:01 a.m. through Wednesday, November 30, 2011 at 11:59 p.m. All entries must be received by Wednesday, November 30, 2011 at 11:59 p.m. E.D.S.T. The geographic area of this promotion is Central Florida. You must be 18 years of age or older, reside in the state of Florida, be a public or private school teacher and your school must be located within Orange, Osceola, Seminole, Lake and Volusia Counties, Florida to enter. Other eligibility limitations apply. See restrictions below. The sponsor of this sweepstakes is Orlando Sentinel Communications Company ("OSC"). Prize provider is Disney Destinations, LLC.
