Reading with the Rays was created in partnership with the Tampa Bay Rays and the Suncoast Credit Union Foundation.

The Tampa Bay Times was awarded a **silver 2016 World Young Reader Prize** in the Enduring Excellence category by the World Association of Newspapers and News Publishers (WAN-IFRA) for its *Enterprise Village Times* program. The *Enterprise Village Times* is a newspaper that is created, printed and sold by students participating in Enterprise Village, the Gus A.
