NIE Teacher of the Year 2014 – 2015

This award recognizes K-12 teachers, literacy coaches and media specialists who advocate for literacy and civic learning through the use of the *Tampa Bay Times* and *Times* NIE curricula.

The 2014 – 2015 award will honor educators who use *Times* NIE instructional materials in their classrooms in an innovative, meaningful way that enhances student learning and the learning environment; employ innovative lessons or strategies, units of study, educational programs or projects to develop students' reading and other literacy skills; and call for close reading of local and state news.

Eligibility

Must be a K-12 teacher in Citrus, Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco or Pinellas counties.

NIE activities must have been implemented during the 2014-2015 academic year.

Teachers may nominate themselves or be nominated by a colleague.
