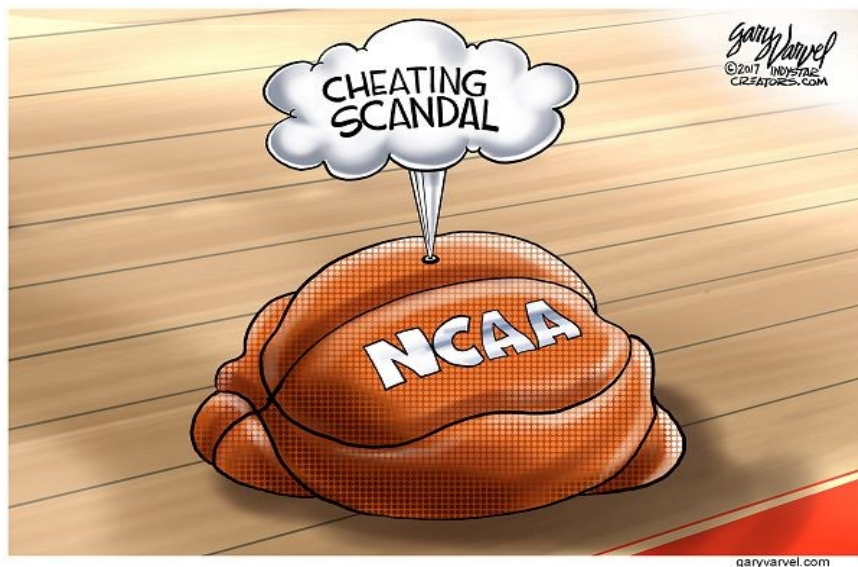




Is money corrupting college sports?
