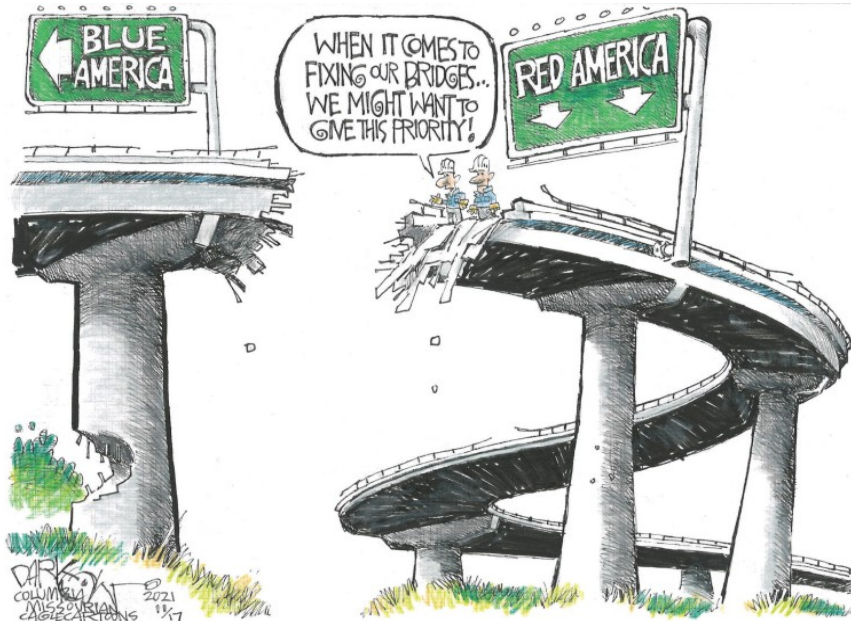




What bridges should we rebuild?

5. How bad is the political divide in the United States? Is it getting better or worse?

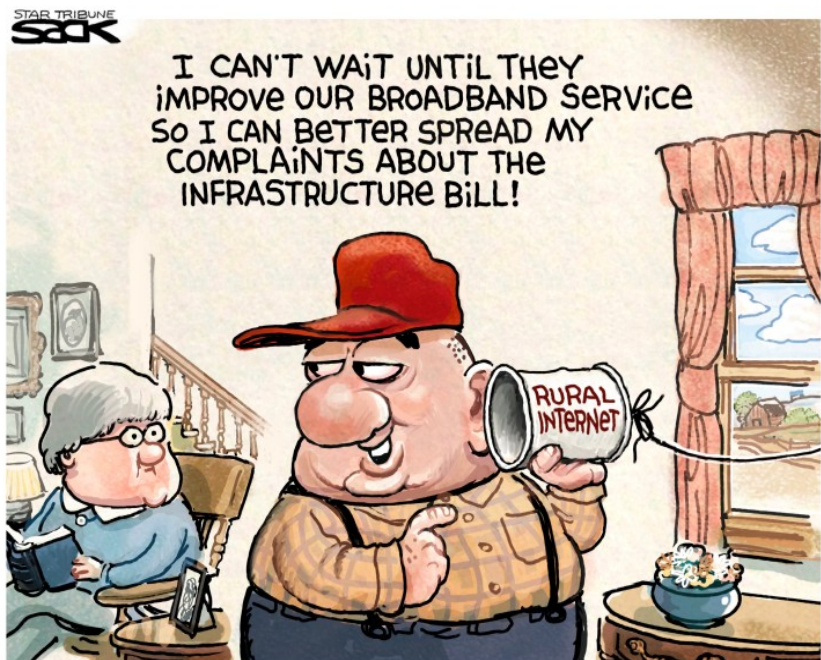
Between the lines
