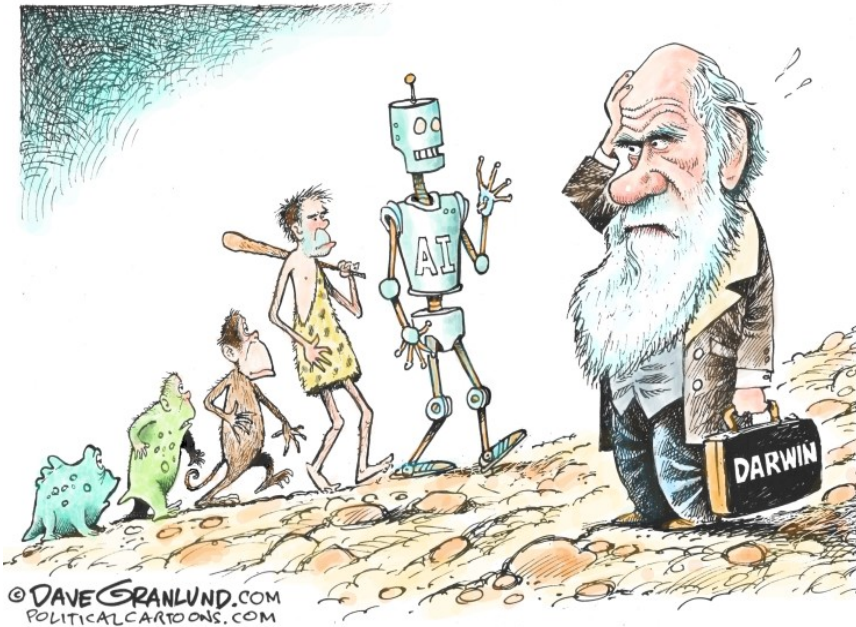




Will artificial intelligence replace us?

5. Scientists recently used AI to find a drug that could treat stubborn infections. Do you think AI could make our lives better?

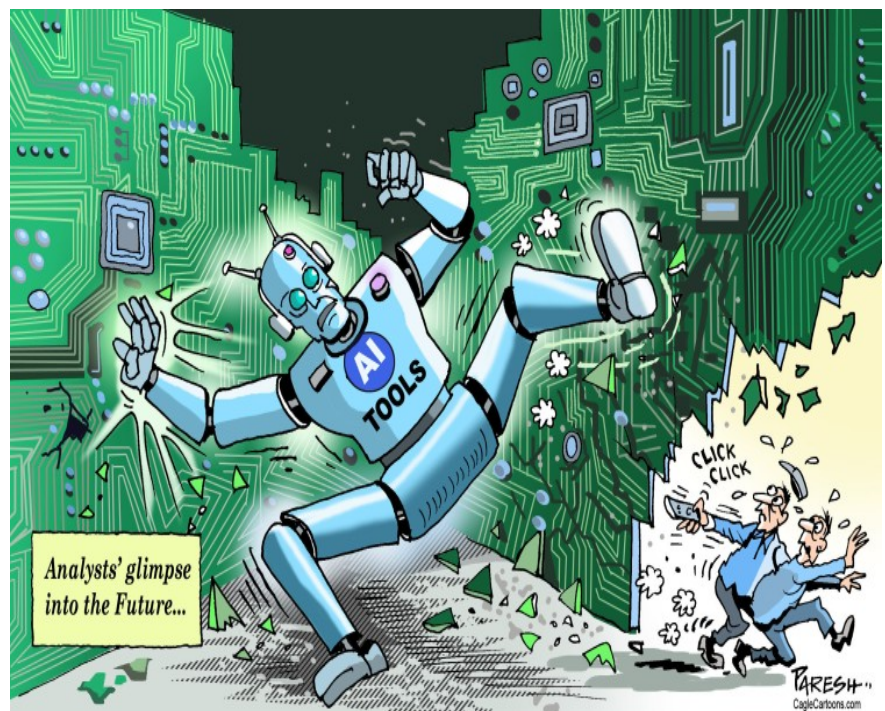
Between the lines
